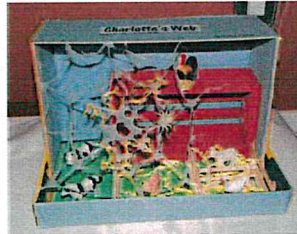
Striving for Excellence: Learning for Life
