Learning for Life – Careers Rotation

WRITE UP

As part of our Learning for Life Rotation in Year 8, all pupils receive 7 hours of dedicated careers education. These lessons begin with exploring what career opportunities are suited to their personality type and the most common ways of gaining employment. Pupils are then given examples of people who are in full time employment and their experiences so far. This includes any advice they would give to someone just starting out. Next we look at what a career path would typically look like, including qualifications that are required and the opportunities for alternative provisions such as apprenticeships. Pupils then investigate financial aspects of gaining employment, such as income, expenditure and tax. Finally, pupils are to prepare for a mock job interview. They investigate what are the most common ways to prepare for a job interview and take part in a live session where they will have the opportunity to interview other class members and be interviewed themselves.

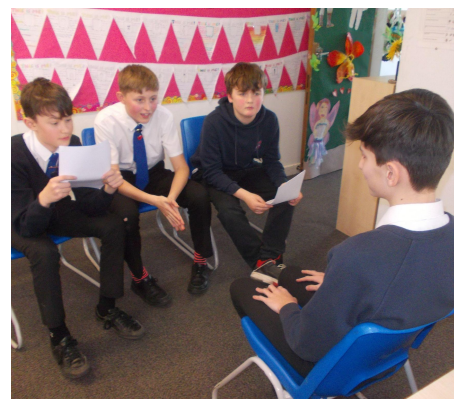
