- Own bedding needed.

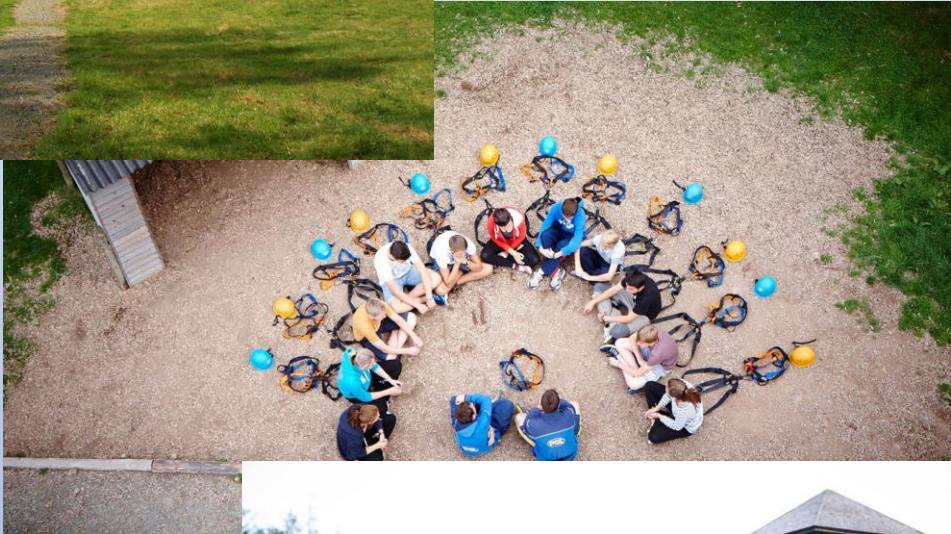
Food!

What does my child need to take?

They must be able to carry their luggage themselves including up the stairs!



They are going for 2 nights and there is limited space.



Kit List - bedding

- Bedding is not provided
- A warm sleeping bag and a pillow / duvet if necessary
- If it can fit into the bag / suitcase please do so. If not, it can be separate.

Clothing

- Night clothes
- Clothes – they will come back wet, muddy and smelly
- Long sleeved, long legged option even if they prefer shorts
- 2x pairs of trainers
- Clothes to go in the lake
- Underwear
- Rain coat
- Coat
- Hoodie

Other items

- Battery operated torch
- Wash bag – shampoo, body wash, tooth paste, tooth brush
- Towel
- Flip flops for in the shower
- Bin bag x2 / plastic bags for wet and/or muddy clothes
- Small bag to carry with them – preferably a rucksack
- Refillable water bottle
- Hair ties

Please label all items with name and school

- There will be over 500 people on site when we are there!
- Lost items will not make their way back if they are not labelled!

Valuables

- There is no electricity, so no phones or smart watches
- No devices of any sort
- A camera if you like, but it is the pupils responsibility to look after it

- Please don't bring anything valuable. We are staying in dormitory rooms and valuables cannot be locked away

- No sweets or chocolate

Weather

- Please check the weather before we go and pack accordingly!
- Pack sun cream and hats or winter woollies and coats as appropriate!



Medication

- In a clear bag labelled with your child's name
- Precise details about dosage and times to be administered
- Needs to be handed to the staff on departure day

Pocket Money

- A maximum of £10 – they will not need any more
- Money needs to put into an envelope
- Please ensure all envelopes are clearly marked with your child's first and last name and the amount in the envelope
- These need to be handed to the staff on departure day

Departure Day

- Please bring your child into school from 8.30 am via the main entrance
- Come into the hall, hand over any medication and pocket money to staff and say good bye
- Pupils are to leave all of their things in the hall and go up to the playground as normal
- They will register as normal

Continued...

- They will need to be in none school uniform, in clothes they can go straight into activities in at PGL in the afternoon.
- They will need a packed lunch that is entirely disposable.
- The first meal at PGL will not be until the evening.
- We will leave school at approximately 10am.
- A parent mail will be sent during the afternoon to let you know we have arrived safely.

Coming home...

- We expect to arrive back at AFMS at approximately 3.45pm.
- A parent mail will be sent on the afternoon to give you a more accurate arrival time.
- Parents need to come into school via the main entrance.
- It will take some time for us to ensure children are correctly matched with luggage and safely allowed home – please be patient with us!

In school...

- On the days pupils are not at PGL, they will be taking part in activities in school.
- Further details will follow about this, but pupils will be in normal school uniform / PE kit
