

Year 6-8 Key Performance Indicators for Design Technology

KPI 1: Can create and communicate alternative ideas using words, labelled sketches and models, showing that they are aware of constraints.

KPI 2: Can reflect on their designs as they develop, bearing in mind the way the product will be used. They evaluate what is working well and what could be improved.

KPI 3: Works with a variety of materials and components safely with increasing accuracy, paying attention to quality of finish and to function. They can select and work with a range of tools and equipment.

KPI 4: Can cook a repertoire of dishes, using a variety of techniques to prepare a broad range of ingredients and healthy recipes.
